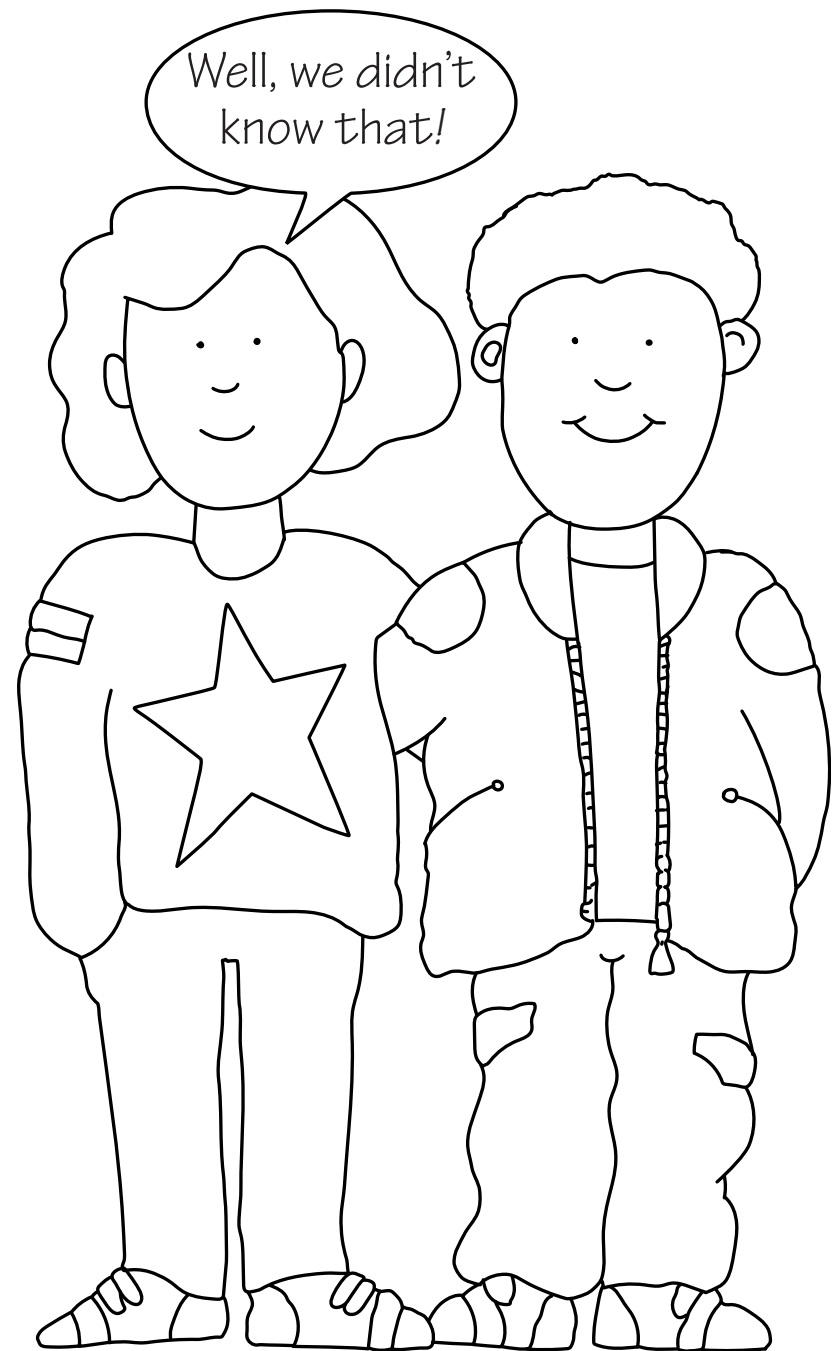


Your body is made of millions and millions of complicated cells. Some of the most important cells protect you from invisible germs and attack any that dare to invade your body.
